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Tudor Lodge Residential Home has been family run since 1995 and is registered for the care of 28 residents. We aim to provide a warm welcoming atmosphere for people who may need professional care and enjoy good food.

Residents are treated as individuals and cared for with respect and dignity within a safe, comfortable and homely setting. Our environment provides stimulation but also respects privacy and independence according to the needs and wishes of those for whom Tudor Lodge is their home.



All our rooms are en-suite and some include a wet room and walk in shower. Rooms are fully furnished to the highest standards. All have televisions and telephone points, together with a nurse call system manned 24 hours a day. Residents may choose to have enhanced television packages in their bedroom and are always welcome to personalise the room as they wish including with items of their own furniture.

The rooms and all areas of the home benefit from full Wi-Fi coverage. Communal bathroom facilities are equipped with the latest bathing solutions, designed for differing resident mobility levels allowing residents to bath or shower alone or with assistance.

Our care manager, an experienced nurse, leads her team in providing discrete and sensitive care to our residents.

Our staff are carefully selected and trained to maintain the relaxed and friendly atmosphere at Tudor Lodge whilst providing the highest standard of care. They will assist in every way they can to bring additional companionship and comfort to our residents.



The dining room at Tudor Lodge is light and airy, where we encourage our residents to join us and enjoy the delicious meals from our daily menu.

Our food is based on traditional home cooking for a healthy, balanced diet using a local butcher and seasonal, locally supplied fresh vegetables. We cater for special dietary needs including diabetic, vegetarian, coeliac and any allergies.

We enjoy a reputation for providing interesting and varied food, making mealtimes a special occasion and providing an opportunity for socialising.

We have a full programme of entertainment which includes; reminiscing, crafts, aromatherapy, chair based exercise, quizzes, a daily happy hour and a wide variety of visiting groups and musicians. Our entertainment co-ordinator also organises outings to local garden centres, parks and pubs and is always open to suggestions from residents about things that they would like to do.

Visitors can come any time and are always made welcome with the offer of a hot drink. We have regular events throughout the year to which we invite family and friends.

We have a weekly GP visit from the local surgery, supplemented by individual appointments when required. Residents may choose to retain their own doctor, alternatively we can make the necessary introduction to a new practice.



Our popular hairdresser visits weekly and we have a chiropodist who comes every 6 weeks, though residents are always welcome to use alternative services. We have regular visits from ministers for anyone who wishes to take communion.

Items of shopping can be organised as part of our regular delivery from the local supermarket and residents choices of daily newspaper and magazines are distributed with the daily post during the morning.



We offer respite and short term care as well as long term residential and palliative care. All permanent admissions start on the basis of a calendar months' trial. During the trial period we work with each resident to carefully create their own care plan. With the resident's approval family and friends are given the opportunity to contribute to the plan of care.


This person centred care plan outlines the particular needs and wishes of the individual and is kept under regular review.

How to find us

Tudor Lodge enjoys a secluded location in Burnham-on-Sea, yet is just over 2 miles from junction 22 of the M5. Entering Burnham from the motorway, or the A38, turn right where signposted for Berrow. An inland lighthouse will be seen on the Berrow Road and Brightstowe Road is the next road on the left hand side. Tudor Lodge is 150 yards down on the right hand side.
